4	Regulation revisions	Update on the revision process for 202 KAR 7:201, 7:301, 7:330, 7:401 & 7:601	Mr. Andrew informed committee members that the regulations are being reviewed and formatted. The tentative submission date to the board is September 21, 2017.
5	ACLS program approval request, Pacific Medical Training	Reconsider request from Pacific Medical Training to approve their ACLS program for Kentucky EMS providers due to regulatory limitation found in <a href="#">202 KAR 7:401. Paramedics</a> , Section 3 (3)	Ms. Bailey made a motion not to approve the ACLS program submitted by Pacific Medical Training due to legal conflict found in 202 KAR 7:401. Paramedics, Section 3 (3) limiting ACLS programs to only the ones listed in the 202 KAR 7:401. Paramedic regulation. Seconded by Ms. Davis, motion passed.
6	NASEMSO National Protocols	Update on protocol revision project	Committee discussed the recent changes made by NASEMSO to the national protocols. No action taken.

**202 KAR 7:020 Section 2. Standing Committees of the Board.** Section 1. Education Committee. (1) The board shall create and recognize a standing committee on EMS Education. (2) The Education Committee shall consist of seven (7) voting member's representative of EMS Educators in the state of Kentucky. At least one (1) voting member of the Education Committee shall also be a member of the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services. (3) The Education Committee shall schedule on an annual basis at least six (6) regular meetings of the committee. (4) The purpose and charge of the Education Committee shall be to: (a) Assist the board in developing a strategic plan for EMS education in the state of Kentucky; (b) Act as a resource for EMS educators and EMS-TEIs in the Commonwealth; and (c) Assume the lead role in formulating, drafting, and sending to the board for approval and subsequent promulgation of all administrative regulations that set the standards and requirements for EMS education in Kentucky.
