**Re:** Meeting Protocols for Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

**THIS MEMORANDUM REPLACES AND SUPERSEDES THE  
MEMORANDUM ISSUED MAY 13, 2021.**

The novel coronavirus (COVID-19) is a respiratory disease causing mild to very severe illness, including death, and many cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed in the Commonwealth. While Kentucky has experienced far too many tragic losses due to COVID-19, we have fared far better than many of our neighbors thanks to the hard work and sacrifices of Team Kentucky.

The three FDA-approved COVID-19 vaccines have been proven through numerous studies to be both safe and highly effective in preventing the deleterious health effects associated with COVID-19. As of today, over 58% of Kentucky's adult population has received at least one dose of a vaccine and over 82% of Kentuckians who are 65 years of age and older have received at least one dose of a vaccine. These numbers are anticipated to continue to increase. Thanks to this great success, Executive Orders 2020-243, 2020-257, 2020-323, 2020-396, 2020-398, 2020-881, 2020-1041, and 2021-326 as well as all Orders of the Cabinet for Health and Family Services implementing the Orders have been rescinded. See Executive Order 2021-386.

Accordingly, Finance Memo: 2021-102, Meeting Protocols for Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), setting forth health precautions to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 for Kentucky Boards and Commissions is hereby rescinded.
