Initial Requirements	
	Current Kentucky Emergency Medical Responder (EMR), Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (AEMT), or Paramedic
	Successful completion of ONE of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><a href="#">The National Association of EMS Educators Emergency Medical Services Education Standards Instructional Guidelines for Educating EMS Educators Course</a></li> <li>The <a href="#">International Fire Service Training Association (IFSTA) Fire Instructor Course (KY Fire Commission)</a></li> <li>Bachelor's Degree (or higher) in Education</li> </ul>
	Minimum of four (4) years certified or licensed as an EMS provider at the same level or higher than level applying for
	Provide a letter from the EMS agency director verifying that two (2) years of the four (4) years' experience required is experience providing care with an EMS organization that complies with the requirements of KRS Chapter 311A or 202 KAR 7.
	Provide Documentation that applicant has assisted with a course that meets the following requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The board has approved the course as leading to certification or licensure.</li> <li>Assistance with the course has been under the supervision of a certified EMS Educator who attests using the board-approved <a href="#">Certified Educator form (KBEMS-E24)</a> that the educator has served as a course coordinator or lead educator for at least three (3) separate courses and who has not been subject to disciplinary action or reprimand by the board pursuant to KRS Chapter 311 A within the past thirty-six (36) months.</li> </ul>
	Completion of required monitored teaching: The course in which the applicant will perform mentored teaching at the same level of EMS educator the applicant is seeking. <b>Level I and II</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Five (5) Presentations and Five (5) Skill Demonstrations. All presentations and skill demonstrations must be on ten (10) separate topics. This must be documented on <a href="#">KBEMS-E20</a></li> <li>Attended a minimum of fifty (50) percent of the clock hours of the course to be documented on <a href="#">KBEMS-E20</a></li> </ul> <b>Level III</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Instruction of fifty (50) classroom clock hours in a minimum of five (5) different subject areas that shall include instruction in pharmacology, cardiac emergencies, and traumatic injuries. This must be documented on <a href="#">KBEMS-E20</a></li> </ul> <p><i>Note: All teaching must meet the objectives of the National Emergency Medical Services Education Standards Instructional Guidelines and EMS Scope of Practice Model National Education for EMR, EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic.</i></p>
	Completion of <a href="#">KBEMS Educator Orientation</a>
