Organizing regional and national level for destination pathways and logistics for putting these together. Where to begin to in order to determine a final destination pathway. PCI centers have better rates of outcomes in cardiac patients. NEMSIS data is not accurate enough for cardiac situations because it stops collecting data once patient is transferred to hospital. Using CARES Registry to track state data for cardiac patients, possibly getting larger health care systems to help fund the state wide CARES Registry Subscription.</p> <p>Step one would be to send out a survey to hospitals to question the hospitals' capabilities with cardiac patients. Will you accept? Can you handle cardiac? Are you a PCI center?</p>
