Below are the amendments to the regulation:</p> <p>1. Motion made by Ms. Franklin, to remove the amended Section 2. EMS-TEI Certification (1) remove line (b) online and/or hybrid and remove clinical and or field internship from line (c) and leave the original language as presented.
